County Youth Summer League 2024 Information, Rules and Regulations

1. Play will be in accordance with the current I.F.N (World Netball) rules with England Netball protocols.

2. E N Codes of Conduct and Safeguarding guidance should be followed by all Clubs entering teams in this League. Clubs are responsible for ensuring that all personnel attending with their club on a match night are aware of their responsibilities to these young players and umpires.

3. All players **must** hold EN membership. (proof of membership should have been sent with your entry to <u>sscnaperformance</u>)

(additions may be made to the registration sheet with membership proof throughout the summer season)

4. Venue:-Phoenix Collegiate, Clarkes Lane, West Bromwich. B71 2BX

5. Fees:- £20 per team per match. Payable by BACs to:- South Staffs CNA.

6. Divisional allocation was based on performance at the Grading Tournament.

7. It has been borne in mind when confirming divisional allocations that this is a "Development League" for young players in new teams or new to the game who would not normally be able to access match play.

In exceptional circumstances and to avoid the cancellation of matches, Teams are expected to take to the court with 5 players. On request to the organising committee

prior to a match, players may transfer into a higher team to help their club fulfil a fixture. This is not to be a regular occurrence.

8. Timing

a) Central timing will be used for matches. Games will start and finish on the umpire's whistle. **The umpire's decision is final in all matters.**

b) Play will be 4 quarters of 10 minutes. 2 minutes for quarter time and 3 minutes half time.

- c) Round 1 will start at 7.00pm. Round 2 will start at 7.55pm
- d) Teams should provide a scorer for each game
- 9. Court layout:-
- Court 1 --- immediately outside the sports hall building entrance
- Court 2 --- nearest one of the 3 other courts
- Court 3 --- middle one of three
- Court 4 --- farthest away of the three near the road
- 10. Registration

a) The Blue Folder contains the Club Team Registration sheet/s and Match Card record.

- b) Arrive in time to record the team on your Match card
- 11. First Aid

Each club is entirely responsible for its own first aid needs.

12. Please ensure that all waste materials generated by your team are taken away and not left on the courts.

13. Please note that dogs are not permitted on the premises and that this is also a smoke free zone.
